New for 2016! The ***Waterfield Place*** offers Boating Excursions!

Capt. Ken will take groups on private small boat tours. The two-hour tours are offered only to our guests, and will give insight to the nearly-freshwater and shallow aquatic environment known as the Currituck Sound. The sound is dotted with marshlands which are home to many species of wildlife. Ducks, geese, heron, egrets, nutria and otters are just a few that guests might see on the tours. Also dotting the sound are the duck blinds that hunters use during the season when migrating species of waterfowl inhabit the sound and marshlands. Another point of interest especially for bird watchers is Monkey Island, which is home to a variety of flora and fauna, wildlife, and marine life. The sound becomes busy in the summer with activities including parasailing, kayaking, windsurfing, jet-skiing, and of course, boating and fishing. The beauty of the Whalehead Club and the Currituck Lighthouse can be seen by guests as they view the shoreline as well as the many homes of resident “Curritucker-s”.

Tours are limited to a maximum of four people. The cost of the two-hour tour is \$100, which includes up to four people, necessary life vests, and detailed information about the sound from Captain Ken.

One day advanced notice is required to book a tour. Tours will be booked based on availability and weather conditions.
